



Important Information for Parents and Students

- The American International School arranges education that follows an international curriculum (IBO) on the elementary as well as secondary (high) school levels.
- Education at the American International School adheres to an international curriculum (IBO) to prepare students for advanced studies abroad.
- The purpose of the education at the American International School on the primary or elementary level is to prepare students for advanced studies abroad and to convey knowledge that facilitates continued studies abroad.

For Education in Sweden

- There are times when students who transfer from an international school to a municipal primary school do not possess knowledge comparable to that possessed by students in the recipient school.
- In an international school, there are not always equivalent subjects and education in the Swedish language may also be limited.
- Students who have attended an international school on the primary level and who apply to secondary school in the public-school system in Sweden should apply for the so-called free quota on the condition that they possess the knowledge required to be admitted to the national curriculum.
- This situation, and how the educational curriculum at an international school on the secondary school level is evaluated and ranked by grades for admission to higher or other post-secondary education, may be decisive in guiding students towards their preferred choice of course of studies.
